Rules & Regulations Section 9 Dock extracted from the Tink Wig Property Owners Association Handbook.

9. Docks

a. General

In consideration for being granted a dock permit, dock owners must sign a release of any and all liability to TWPOA. Docks are to be the sole responsibility of the owner. No structures will be permitted on docks with the exception of a securely fastened bench for seating. No electrical hookups will be allowed on docks. A permit is required from TWPOA prior to placing a dock on Tink Wig Lake. (Violation = \$500.00 plus \$25.00 per day until the permit is issued). TWPOA reserves the right to revoke a dock permit if the owner is declared a member not in good standing or if the owner fails to maintain the dock.

b. Construction

Only "floating" docks securely anchored are permitted. Permanent, non-floating docks are prohibited. All flotation for docks shall be of materials commercially manufactured for marine use. Flotation materials shall be fabricated so as not to become water-logged, crack, peel, fragment, or subject to loss of beads. Flotation materials shall be resistant to puncture or penetration.

Dock frames are to be made of marine grade aluminum or other approved non-rusting, non-corroding material. Decking on all docks shall not be pressure treated. All docks shall be constructed so that they can be removed upon request of TWPOA.

c. Placement

Docks must be placed a least fifteen (15) feet from the side lot lines. Docks shall be built at right angles to the shoreline. Docks shall be anchored in place.

d. Dimensions

Walking areas may be no more than six (6) feet wide. Docks may not extend more than twenty (20) feet from the shoreline. Docks shall not exceed 84 square feet in size excluding ramps.

e. Visibility Requirements

Reflectors are required on all corners of the terminals of all docks facing open water and every six (6) feet on both sides of walkways leading from the shore to the terminals. All reflectors must be between six (6) and eighteen (18) inches above the water line.

f. DEP permit must be submitted with TWPOA application.
